Category	Type	Variety	Description
Vegetable	Artichoke	Green Globe	Tasty! Needs a fairly long and mild growing season, or can be grown as an annual. This colorful plant makes a great ornamental as well.
Vegetable	Broccoli	Calabrese	An early broccoli of excellent quality for fresh use or for freezing. Forms 3"-4" heads on numerous side shoots.
Vegetable	Broccoli	Di Cicco	An Italian classic, 'Di Cicco' is a superb variety, producing numerous, small to medium-sized heads well into the summer for more delicious broccoli more often! We recommend harvesting the main head when it is 3" in diameter; this will encourage side shoots. Good freezer variety; leaves are also edible, cooked like chard.
Vegetable	Cabbage	Pointed Sweetheart	A traditional European specialty, these handsome cabbages have a solid, rounded, tightly wrapped base of leaves that taper to a point. Flavor is consistently mild and remarkably sweet. Heads grow quickly and are uniform and heavy for their size with strong wrapper leaves and great weather tolerance.
Vegetable	Cauliflower	Snowball	Unequaled for quality. Pure white heads are large, smooth and very solid. Delicious and nutritious raw or cooked, having high Vitamin A content.
Vegetable	Celery	Merlin	European variety developed especially for home gardens. These early producing, vigorous plants reliably yield tall 12" tender stalks. Enjoy right from the garden as an easy, cooling treat, and harvest the juicy stalks for fresh salads or crunchy sweet snacks. Add to soups, stews and many other dishes. Air dry the leaves to use in winter cooking. Celery is an excellent source of vitamin K as well as folate and potassium.
Vegetable	Chard	Cardinal	This Swiss Chard has a deep crimson stalk that runs into the veins of the leaves. The leaves are glossy dark and heavily crumpled. Cardinal's stalks can be cooked like asparagus while the leaves like spinach. Can be used raw.
Vegetable	Chard	Swiss Chard Mix	Multi-colored stems brighten both vegetable and flower gardens with an attractive rainbow of colors. Stems have a mild chard flavor. Harvest in 30-60 days.
Vegetable	Cilantro		Cilantro is considered essential to the cuisines of many cultures, from Mexican to Thai and no matter your cooking style, no garden is complete without cilantro. Try planting frequent successions, just a few weeks apart is the best method to ensure the most fresh and flavorful cilantro.

Category	Type	Variety	Description
Vegetable	Crysanthemum	Garland Serrated Leaf	This highly valued Japanese vegetable green is an edible chrysanthemum and has serrated, dark-green aromatic leaves. The serrated leaf type has a flavor that is stronger than the round leaf type and intensifies with maturity. This easy to grow, cool weather plant has high yields and produces many side shoots. Harvest leaves and young stems when plant is 4-6" tall.
Vegetable	Kale	Dinosaur / Lacinto	This striking heirloom Italian leaf-kale is also known as Lacinato Kale, Black Palm Cabbage, Toscana Cabbage, and Dinosaur Kale. Deep-green savored leaves grow to 24" long and look like a palm tree! Flavorful and beautiful in an edible landscape. Prefers cool weather and ample, even moisture.
Vegetable	Kale	Dwarf Blue Curled	From the 1800s, is extremely hardy and will overwinter in all but the coldest climates. Like most greens, grows best in cool weather but will also withstand some heat. Leaves are rich in vitamins and minerals, low in calories. The flavor of the leaves is sweetened after a light frost; delicious in winter soups!
Vegetable	Kale	Purple Moon	Purple Moon has beautiful frilled & ruffled, deep purple leaves that are loaded with great flavor & super nutrition. The plants germinate and grow vigorously, and can be harvested over a long, productive season. Purple Moon has a mild and nutty flavor that is perfect for fresh salads or quick cooking.
Vegetable	Kale	Russian Red	This variety is sweeter and more tender than other kales, especially during warm weather. The red-veined bunching leaves will also tolerate extreme cold which deepens the color.
Vegetable	Leek	King Richard	Leeks' mild but rich onion flavor and cold tolerance make them a favorite in home kitchens and gardens. This onion relative has compact stems that thicken but do not form bulbs like onions. 'King Richard' produces extra long white stems early. Enjoy fresh, grilled, sautéed, and added to soups and stews.
Vegetable	Leek	Striesen	German heirloom leek that grows tall and straight with long, sturdy, fine-flavored white stalks and hearty green tops. Holds very well in the garden for easy, extended harvesting.
Vegetable	Lettuce	Butter-crunch	This heat-tolerant, Bibb-type lettuce earned All America status in 1963. Its rich green leaves, sometimes tinged with red, form a beautiful rosette in the garden that holds well under stress and has good bolt resistance. A good source of vitamin A and phytonutrients. Grows best in full sun, but will tolerate partial shade and even appreciates it in spring in hot climates.
Vegetable	Lettuce	Jericho	Especially heat-tolerant, juicy romaine originally from Israel. Full heads of upright sword-shaped leaves with crisp, juicy texture and sweet, fine flavor.
Vegetable	Lettuce	Little Gem	The small, robust green heads are perfect for individual salads, and its firm upright habit makes it great for sandwiches as well. Little Gem is the one to grow for Hearts of Romaine.
Vegetable	Mustard	Japanese Giant Red	Beautiful, large, Japanese type. Purple-red leaves with a delicious, strong, sharp, almost garlic-like, mustard flavor. Tasty stir-fried or boiled and makes a great pickling variety.

Vegetable	Pak Choi	Green Fortune	Heat-resistant baby variety rapidly produces cute and chubby mini heads of pak choi whose crispy pastel stalks and deep green leaves size up and are ready to eat in record time. Perfect for spring or fall planting, and very ornamental in neat garden beds or rows, the 6-8" compact, vase-shaped heads are mild, sweet and crunchy. This easy to grow vegetable makes wonderful quick stir fries, or braise it for a succulent side dish.
Vegetable	Pea	Green Arrow	An English main crop variety and standard home and market variety. Slim pointed pods are 4-5" long and contain 8-11 small deep green peas. Pods are almost always borne in doubles. Very heavy reliable production. Medium vines grow 24-28" tall. Shell, 62-70 days.
Vegetable	Pea	Green Beauty	A magnificent, giant! The largest we have seen! Green pods are tender even harvested at their full size of up to 8" long. Vigorous plants are productive and reach 6-8' tall in ideal conditions. Delicious, tender pods are likely the largest of all!
Vegetable	Pea	Laxton's Progress No 9	This variety was developed at the turn of the 20th century by Thomas Laxton, vegetable breeder known for his pea varieties. These early, plump shelling peas grow on short, manageable vines - 20 to 24 inches in height. Each pod dependably yields 6-9 large, tender and deliciously-flavored peas.
Vegetable	Pea	Oregon Sugar Pod II	Homegrown peas taste so much better than store bought! 'Oregon Sugar Pod II' produces a huge number of 4" delicious pods that are harvested and eaten when the pods are flat, before the seeds form. Short, 28" vines are easy to manage. Resists mildew, pea enation virus, and leaf roll. Excellent freezer and late-summer variety. Grow on a trellis.
Vegetable	Pea	Sugar Daddy Snap	Slender, 3" pods have a deep green color adding to their appeal. The short plants reach only 24"-30" tall and don't need support; a short fence or trellis will make it easier to find and harvest.. Pods can be served fresh by themselves or with dip, or added to give crunch to salads. Add to stir-fries and soups or steam for a delicious vegetable. Resistant to powdery mildew and tolerant to bean leaf roll virus.
Vegetable	Pea	Sugar Snap	Sweet, crisp pods, Sugar Snap germinates well in cold, wet soil, and the vigorous plants quickly produce a thick stand that requires support. Vines avg. 72" with 1 or 2 pods per node. Yields well over a long season in both hot and cold weather. Remove string from pods before cooking. Needs trellising.
Vegetable	Spinach	Bloomsdale Long Standing	High yields, rich flavor and slow to bolt. Thick, dark-green leaves are tender and beautifully crinkled. High in vitamins. If limited for gardening space, try a deep container to grow multiple heads.
Vegetable	Spinach	Catalina	Nicely shaped, crunchy textured young leaves are just perfect to harvest at baby size for scrumptious fresh spinach salads. Fast growth and bolt-resistance are bred right into Catalina, and its smooth leaves have a mild, nutty flavor with no metallic overtones. The plants are vigorous, productive and long standing. Plan on going right into the garden with your salad bowl to pick the deep green oval leaves at their fresh flavor peak.

Flower	Sweet Pea	Explorer Mix	With early blooming flowers and the most beautiful color range, our Explorer is the best short, non-climbing sweet pea, perfect for beds and borders. The bushy 2 ½' plants soon bear beguiling, dainty winged blossoms with exquisite honeyed fragrance in entrancing rich hues of deep rose, lavender, salmon, mid-blue, rose crimson, pink, scarlet and white. Flower stems are long enough to cut for long lasting perfumed bouquets.
Flower	Sweet Pea	Fire and Ice	Fire and Ice is our blend of winged and ruffled sweet peas in a trio of contrasting and complimentary colors: vivid orange/scarlet, soft creamy white and rich deep crimson. These vibrant, scented flowers bloom happily on tall climbing vines, offering many stems with multiple blossoms. Plant pretty Fire and Ice where the striking color combination can shine in the garden. Cut flowers often to enjoy their lovely scent indoors.
Flower	Sweet Pea	Royal Family Mix	This sweet pea flower variety is wonderfully fragrant. Showy blooms flower freely over annual vines. Spring blooming, floribunda type. Thrives in cooler weather.
Flower	Sweet Pea	Queen of Hearts	Queen of Hearts is composed of heat-tolerant antique varieties that blossom in bouquets of crimson-red, deep burgundy, magenta-rose and cream. Together the irresistible colors make a regal blend of vivid flowers with delicate form and delicious honey-orange perfume.
