Flower		Description
California Fuchsia		<p><i>Epilobium canum</i>. California/Santa Clara County native perennial. 1-3' tall and spreads via rhizomes. Full sun to part shade. Profuse red blooms cover this hummingbird favorite from summer into fall. Cut to the base in late fall or early winter to stimulate new growth. Unwanted rhizomes can be pulled at any time. Drought tolerant, but occasional water improves appearance.</p>
California Sand Aster		<p><i>Corethrogyne filaginifolia</i>. California/Santa Clara County native perennial. Up to 1' tall and 4' wide. Full sun to part shade. A dense carpet of evergreen, silvery foliage that sports a multitude of lavender, daisy-like flowers from summer into fall. Tolerates clay soil. Water once a week once established or naturalize.</p>
Geranium		<p>Geranium is a genus of 422 species of annual, biennial, and perennial plants that are commonly known as geraniums or cranesbills. They are found throughout the temperate regions of the world and the mountains of the tropics, with the greatest diversity in the eastern part of the Mediterranean region.</p>

Flower		Description
Scarlet Monkeyflower		<p><i>Erythranthe cardinalis</i>. California/Santa Clara County native perennial. Up to 3' tall and 2' wide. Full sun to part shade, but it seems to do best in partially shaded areas. An herbaceous, creeping plant with downy, apple green leaves and tubular orange-red flowers that is a hummingbird magnet. Blooms from summer into fall. Cut back hard in late fall or early winter to improve appearance. Self-sows. Does well in containers. Provide regular water.</p>
Snapdragon: Black Prince		<p>Tender perennial. Gorgeous deep crimson flower spikes bloom above glossy green foliage that darkens to bronze-purple in cool weather. 'Black Prince' is a shorter variety that needs no staking-sending up its spires of smoldering velvets at the edge of cottage gardens to mid-border. Provide rich, neutral to slightly alkaline soil, deadhead, and feed regularly for lavish blooms.</p>
Sweet Pea: Spencer Ruffled & April in Paris Mix		<p><b>Spencer Ruffled:</b> This lovely mix represents the royalty of classic English Spencer sweet peas, with perfectly formed, big ruffled flowers. The long stems of beautiful blossoms make glorious scented displays both in the garden and as perfumed bouquets.</p> <p><b>April in Paris:</b> The large ruffled blossoms are a soft primrose cream, tinted at the edges in dark lilac that deepens and increases with age. These strong growing vines produce heavy sets of long-stemmed flowers that beg to be cut for heavenly scented bouquets.</p>
