Herb	Cilantro	Bac Lieu		The flavor of fast-growing Bac Lieu Vietnamese Cilantro is mild and delicate with an extra citrus twist. The plants resemble regular cilantro but the foliage is topped with fine cut, frilly leaves. Enjoy at every growth stage, as Bac Lieu plants hold their delicious flavor even as they mature and begin to flower.			
Herb	Cilantro	Heirloom		Cilantro is considered essential to the cuisines of many cultures, from Mexican to Thai and no matter your cooking style, no garden is complete without cilantro. Try planting frequent successions, just a few weeks apart is the best method to ensure the most fresh and flavorful cilantro.			
Herb	Dill	Bouquet		Particularly good for pickling because of early and abundant seed production, 'Bouquet's' foliage is also delicious sprinkled on potatoes, tomatoes, salmon, spinach, cucumbers, and lamb chops. Very aromatic. Dill is an important host plant for caterpillars of swallowtail butterflies.			
Herb	Dill	Mammoth Long Island		Mammoth Dill is highly aromatic and used to make dill pickles. Seeds will germinate in 7-14 days. Mature plants can be harvested when the lower part of a seed cluster is ripe.			
Herb	Dill	Tetra		Tetra' is a bushy, late flowering variety, meaning more leaf production for dill lovers. It is heat tolerant which makes it slow-to- bolt, so you will enjoy fresh picked, aromatic dill throughout the season.			
Herb	Fennel	Grosfruchtiger (Leaf)	50-60	Vigorous leaf production and sweet flavor. Nonbulbing type. Leaves are a nice addition to salads, coleslaw, and dressings.			
Herb	Fennel	Smokey Bronze Fennel (Leaf)		Striking 4-5' plumes of filigreed coppery leaves and lacy golden flower umbels that ripen mellow anise-flavored seeds. Smokey Bronze Fennel makes a stunning addition to flower or herb beds and is a major nectar & pollen host for many butterfly and beneficial insect species.			
Herb	Marjoram	Marjoram		A very popular ingredient in German sausage and herb breads.			

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Herb	Parsley	Italian Gigante		The deep green, flavorful leaves are wonderful; add a healthy handful of the chopped leaves to every green salad you make to heighten both flavor and nutrition. Sprinkle liberally on potatoes, rice, seafood and pasta and to finish soups and stews. Grow some in a big pot near your kitchen where you can cut it often to enjoy in everyday cooking.
Miscellaneou	California Buckeye	-	-	Aesculus californica. California/Santa Clara County native tree. Between 15-40' tall with a spread of 30-60'. Full sun to part shade. Grows as a multi-trunk, rounded tree with silver-white bark and large compound leaves. Leaves appear in late winter/early spring, followed by fragrant, white, bottlebrush-like flowers on branch ends which serve as an important nectar source for native bees and migrating butterflies. Large, spherical seeds form in summer as the tree tends to go deciduous. Mature seeds drop in fall and germinate readily. Water twice a month once established. Drought tolerant, but appearance is improved with some water. May be kept as a specimen in a large (30+ gallon) container and can flower in as little as five years. Caution: All parts of the fruit are toxic.
Miscellaneou	Calamansi / Calamondin			The Calamansi or Calamondin is a hybrid fruit - think half mandarin orange and half kumquat. They are edible with a sweet peel and a sour bite. They are especially great for baked goods, jams, and cocktails. Most notably, the calamondin's year round blooming cycle offers a stunning transformation of dark green leaves, white flower petals, and bright orange fruit. Calamondins are also known for the fresh citrus aroma they give off when in bloom. The fruits are sour and are often used for preserves or cooking. The calamansi bears a small citrus fruit that is used to flavor foods and drinks. Despite its outer appearance and its aroma, the taste of the fruit itself is quite sour, although the peel is sweet. Calamansi marmalade can be made in the same way as orange marmalade. The fruit is a source of vitamin C.
Vegetable	Arugula	Rustic Style		The arching, deeply cut, leafy stems also grow more slowly and hold longer in the garden than the common variety.
Vegetable	Arugula	Slow Bolt	30	Slow Bolt has the same peppery taste you know and love, but adds an extra week or two of harvest to your spring arugula crop.
Vegetable	Arugula	Wasabi	30-40	A unique wild arugula, Wasabi's leaves taste just like the complex, spicy flavor of freshly made wasabi paste. These delicious little plants grow quickly and easily, forming pretty leafy rosettes.
Vegetable	Beet	Golden	55	Golden beets are a beautiful golden-orange color throughout. They stay tender-fleshed and are particularly sweet and mild in taste, whether pulled very young or allowed to size up. Their tops also make great tasting greens.

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Vegetable	Bok Choy	Tatsoi Rosette	42-45	This delicious and beautiful Asian green grows quickly and easily in both spring and fall. Rosette Tatsoi speedily forms round flat rosettes of rich green, teardrop shaped leaves. At maturity, the big heads measure a foot in diameter. Tatsoi's tender, succulent leaves have a wonderful mild flavor, sweeter than most other Asian greens. Tatsoi adds both color and flavor to fresh green salads or enjoy it in stir-fries. This vitamin and antioxidant rich powerhouse is a great ornamental edible.
Vegetable	Broccoli	Di Cicco	48	An Italian classic, 'Di Cicco' is a superb variety, producing numerous, small to medium-sized heads well into the summer for more delicious broccoli more often! We recommend harvesting the main head when it is 3" in diameter; this will encourage side shoots. 'Di Cicco' is a good freezer variety; leaves are also edible, cooked like chard.
Vegetable	Broccoli	Purple Sprouting	120-200	An heirloom sprouting broccoli variety with legions of fans in Italy and England who are mad for its beautiful deep-purple sprouts and high nutritional content.
Vegetable	Broccoli Raab	Super Rapini	60	Also known as "cima di rapa" or "rapini," this robust and rich- tasting traditional Italian heirloom is a quick growing, cool season favorite. Broccoli Raab produces an abundance of deep green leaves and tender shoots topped with tiny bud clusters. Enjoy these full-flavored greens sautéed in olive oil and garlic as Italian food lovers have for time immemorial.
Vegetable	Cabbage	All Seasons	60-65	Round and flattened on top, All Seasons usually grows 8" deep and 10" in diameter. Heat resistant and a strong grower.
Vegetable	Cabbage	Beka Santoh	25-40	This vigorous loose head variety is grown throughout Japan. The leaves are light green, frilled and slightly serrated. The petioles are white. Fast growing.
Vegetable	Cabbage	Copenhagen Market	65-80	Quick-to-mature cabbage heads are 6"-8" in diameter and 3-4 pounds, tightly wrapped, and perfect for small gardens. Adaptable to a range of climates. Resists splitting and stores up to 6 months.
Vegetable	Cabbage	Early Jersey Wakefield	60-75	This early-maturing variety is delicious eaten fresh. The conical, solid, tightly held heads grow up to 15" long by 7" wide and weigh 3-4 pounds each.
Vegetable	Cabbage	Golden Acre	65	A very early, high-quality cabbage. The dense, solid heads are spherical, 5-7" in diameter and weigh 3-5 pounds. Plants are very compact relative to the size of the heads, allowing closer spacing than some varieties.
Vegetable	Cabbage	Mammoth Red Rock	90-100	The perfectly shaped, compact heads of Mammoth Red Rock cabbage are ideal for urban farmers! This open-pollinated purple heirloom variety has many valuable characteristics. Harvest the head when small or let it get quite large!

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Vegetable	Cabbage	Red Acre	75-100	Perk up cole slaw or your favorite stir-fry with this gorgeous, deep- red cabbage. The sweet flavor of cabbage fresh from the garden is much better than store-bought.
Vegetable	Cabbage	Savoy Perfection	90	Savoy leaf cabbages are perfect for summer slaw dishes and bright in winter soups.
Vegetable	Cabbage (Nappa)	Aiko (F1)	60	Big, dense, full-sized 12" heads with tightly wrapped, blemish-free outer leaves and light green to creamy white interiors. These crisp, juicy, heavy heads have a delicious mild, sweet flavor.
Vegetable	Cauliflower	Snowball	70-80	Unequaled for quality. Pure white heads are large, smooth and very solid. Delicious and nutritious raw or cooked, having high Vitamin A content.
Vegetable	Cauliflower	Purple Crush	75-80	This top-quality new cauliflower grows smoothly into big domed heads with a beautiful rich purple color and superb mild, nutty, sweet flavor.
Vegetable	Cauliflower	Romanesco	75-100	Cooked, 'Romanesco' has a delicious nutty flavor and a texture similar to cauliflower.
Vegetable	Chard	Cardinal	54	This Swiss Chard has a deep crimson stalk that runs into the veins of the leaves. The leaves are glossy dark and heavily crumpled. Cardinal's stalks can be cooked like asparagus while the leaves like spinach. However both can be used raw.
Vegetable	Chard	Gold Silverbeet	50	This variety has golden stems and veins that contrast beautifully with its green, glossy leaves. It is a uniform and productive strain.
Vegetable	Chard	Lucullus	60	Harvest mild-flavored, sweet, green leaves for months with this flavorful and high-yielding variety. One of the earliest varieties of chard, Swiss Lucullus Chard produces savoyed, dark green leaves on top of pale ivory, celery-like stalks. The leaves can be eaten raw, sautéed or cooked into your favorite recipes while the stems can be cooked into a variety of soups and other dishes. Packed with vitamins, this chard produces heavy yields and does not bolt. It tolerates hot weather and holds well after cutting. Best of all, it keeps growing and producing until frost
Vegetable	Chard	Italian Silver Rib	50	A long-time favorite of Italian cooks for its flavor and substance, this fine variety has wide, crisp, silvery-white midribs and crinkled, shiny green leaves. The large-framed, handsome plants grow easily and vigorously from spring through late fall. Heirloom Silver Rib produces an abundance of big succulent leaves with sweet crunchy stalks to enjoy as mild, mellow-tasting greens. You'll find it consistently delicious simply steamed with fresh lemon, sautéed with aromatics or added to stir-fries, soups, and casseroles.

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Vegetable	Chard	Orange	45	Stunning orange stems with dark green leaves. The orange color remains after cooking. Plants are heat tolerant and make a delicious addition to salads. Early maturing and extremely productive. The earthy flavor and beautiful color of this variety will add brightness to any salad. Grows 18-24" tall.
Vegetable	Chard	Rainbow	60	This multi-colored Swiss Chard mix satisfies everyone's end-of- the-rainbow wishes, with succulent-stemmed leaves in shades of red, yellow, orange, and cream. Grow this chard and you'll see: a good garden is more valuable than a pot of gold.
Vegetable	Chard	Scarlet Charlotte	50	The wide crunchy stalks and leaf veins are a gorgeous magenta red that contrasts perfectly with the deep green savoyed leaves. This highly ornamental and weather tolerant chard's vibrant color lights up the garden and will be equally at home in both your vegetable and flower beds. In the kitchen, the pretty leaves and stalks are versatile, succulent and good tasting.
Vegetable	Chard	Special Baby Leaf	30-35	Easily grown by the "cut and come again" method, seeds are sown thickly, then cut as needed at 4-5 inches tall, leaving crowns to regrow for multiple additional harvests. With its tender texture and milder flavor, baby leaf chard makes wonderful garden- fresh salads.
Vegetable	Chinese Broccoli/ Gai Lan	Early Jade (F1)	40-50	Great tasting "superfood" Gai Lan is a cool season crop, ready to start harvesting in just 6 to 7 weeks. Its flavor is similar to fresh broccoli, but more mild and sweet and just delicious simply stir fried or quickly sautéed.
Vegetable	Chinese Broccoli/ Gai Lan	Yod Fah	60-70	The delectable, tender stalks taste like a cross between asparagus and broccoli, only sweeter. Our favorite spring vegetable, this is a very easy-to-grow broccoli-like plant from China.
Vegetable	Collards	Georgia Southern	50-80	Georgia Southern is a large collard plant with a cabbage-like taste! This variety produces bluish-green leaves that can grow up to 36" tall and do not bunch or head like cabbage leaves. These large open heads are great for cooking or freezing. The Georgia Southern collard is vitamin rich, sweet, not bitter, heat tolerant, and frost hardy.
Vegetable	Collard	Green Flash	55	Easy to grow Green Flash forms dense, 18 inch tall rosettes of thick, tender, big paddle-shaped leaves. This top-notch variety offers uniformity, vigor, high yields and bolt resistance for rapid regrowth and longer, more dependable harvests.
Vegetable	Endive	Tres Fine Maraichere	30-50	Quick growing miniature French "frisée" type endive. Narrow finely curled leaves can be grown for baby leaves or larger mature leaves. Excellent delicate flavor when harvested young.

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Vegetable	Fennel - Bulbing	Florence	80+	Called finocchio in Italy, fennel's licorice flavored, overlapping leaves form a bulb-like enlargement at the base of the celery-like stalks. The bulb is great in stir-fry dishes, soups, and raw in salads. Fennel also grows well in containers, and its feathery blue-green foliage make it an excellent choice for a courtyard garden or a pot.
Vegetable	Greens	Claytonia / Miner's Lettuce	40	Quantities of heart-shaped leaf pairs, each "wrapped" around a white-flowered stem. Can tolerate moderate frost and can be grown all winter in mild regions or in cold greenhouses. Also known as miner's lettuce.
Vegetable	Greens	Erba Stella Minutina (RARE)	50	This variety is one of the sweetest, most tender winter greens in the world. Because it normally grows wild, it is very easy to grow and doesn't require rich soil in order to flourish.
Vegetable	Kale	Black Magic	65	Think Lacinato Kale, but with a deeper color and milder flavor! This new favorite is loved for its hardiness as it thrives in both spring and warmer weather; its leaves are abundant and will reappear again and again! Enjoy cooked, raw or juiced!
Vegetable	Kale	Dinosaur / Lacinato	65	This striking heirloom Italian leaf-kale is also known as Lacinato Kale, Black Palm Cabbage and Dinosaur Kale. Deep-green, heavily savored leaves grow to 24" long and look like a palm tree! Flavorful and so beautiful in the edible landscape. Prefers cool weather and ample, even moisture.
Vegetable	Kale	Dwarf Blue Curled	55	Dwarf Blue Curled', from the 1800s, is extremely hardy and will overwinter in all but the coldest climates. Like most greens, it grows best in cool weather but will also withstand some heat. Leaves are rich in vitamins and minerals and low in calories. The flavor of the leaves is sweetened after a light frost; delicious in winter soups!
Vegetable	Kale	Dutch Darkibor	50	The triple curled, rich green leaves of this top-quality Dutch variety are mild, juicy-sweet and tender: a perfect choice for vitamin-rich, garden fresh kale salads, kale "chips" and a whole range of traditional cooked dishes. Darkibor grows effortlessly into 18 inch tall, dense leafy rosettes of frilled rich green leaves. This striking edible landscaping plant is at home in both vegetable and ornamental gardens. You'll be enjoying this great tasting, weather tolerant variety for months.
Vegetable	Kale	Mars Landing	50	Mars Landing kale has a truly "out of this world" appearance! The tender leaves are a wonderful bronzy purple/maroon color with light green underneath and notched and scalloped edges. Besides its sensational appearance, this tender, mild and very tasty variety holds well in the garden without getting tough or stringy or losing quality. Enjoy nutrition-packed, richly colored Mars Landing kale for months in delicious salads, or steam, braise or add to soups and stews.

This is excellent for making wraps, and is also great for juicing, salads, and can be used to make kale chips. It is not too crinkly or narrow like other varieties making for a very delicious and useful vegetable. A cross between kale and collards is one of the best varieties to grow. Excellent Source Of Vitamin C, K, Iron, and Fiber.
Vegetable	Kale	Purple Moon	70	Purple Moon has beautiful frilled & ruffled, deep purple leaves that are loaded with great flavor & super nutrition. The plants germinate and grow vigorously, and can be harvested over a long, productive season. Purple Moon has a mild and nutty flavor that is perfect for fresh salads or quick cooking.
Vegetable	Kale	Scarlet	65-80	This stunning purple kale is one of the darkest kale varieties in the world. The hotter the weather gets, the deeper purple it becomes. Cold hardy and frost tolerant. The plant is packed with nutrients and antioxidants due to its purple color. Great in salads or juiced. A VERY rare and sought-after variety.
Vegetable	Kale	Tronchuda Beira	60	Great for juicing/smoothies because of its tender texture & mild flavor. This delicious specialty kale comes directly from Portugal where it is a center stage vegetable, beloved for its taste and easy culture.Portuguese kale forms 12 to 18 inch tall heads of paddle- shaped, deep blue-green leaves. This vigorous variety offers long continuous harvests.
Vegetable	Kohlrabi	Green Vienna	50-60	Crispy round bulbs with thin pastel green skins and crunchy mild white flesh. Eat them peeled and sliced thin for healthy low- calorie snacks, use for crispy slaw or cook for savory side dishes.
Vegetable	Leek	Striesen	110	German heirloom leek that grows tall and straight with long, sturdy, fine-flavored white stalks and hearty green tops. Holds very well in the garden for easy, extended harvesting.
Vegetable	Leek	Giant Musselburgh	85-150	AKA Scotch Flag. Scottish variety introduced in the early 1800s. Enormous leeks that are 9-15" long by 2-3" in diameter. Tender white stalks, dark blue-green fan-shaped leaves. Mild flavor, stands winter well. Good buncher for market gardens. 80-150 days from transplant.
Vegetable	Lettuce	Buttercrunch	65	This extremely popular heirloom lettuce has a luscious, buttery texture. The soft heads are creamy yellow inside and have some heat resistance. Best in cooler regions. Plant early in spring and repeat every 2 weeks into fall. Protect from heat with shade cloth. Likes fertile soil, ample water. Best when picked minutes before your meal. Space lettuce plants 8" apart.

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Vegetable	Lettuce (Butterhead)	Bronze Mignonette	65	This variety is a heat tolerant lettuce that is slow bolting. Bronze Mignette gets its name for having a bronze tint. The lettuce heads reach 8" across with crumply, crisp leaves. This variety looks and tastes in salads and on sandwiches.
Vegetable	Lettuce (Butterhead)	Drunken Woman Frizzy Headed	55	This unique butterhead forms a savoyed head. Robust 8 inch plants have mint green leaves that are tinged in mahogany red.
Vegetable	Lettuce (Bibb/Butterhead)	Tennis Ball	55	Loose and petite heads, 4-6" in diameter, Bibb or Butterhead type.
Vegetable	Lettuce (Looseleaf)	Italienisher	55	Once you grow this variety, you'll know why many people describe Italienischer as a truly magnificent lettuce. Tall, upright, and sturdy 18" bright green plants are huge, providing more sustenance per plant than any other variety.
Vegetable	Lettuce (Looseleaf)	Lolla Rosa	45	Lolla Rossa Leaf lettuce is a curly, dark purple leaf lettuce. An ideal variety for "cutting and growing". Simply snip off as much as you need and more will grow in its place! Does extremely well in containers.
Vegetable	Lettuce (Romaine)	Crisp Mint	60-65	A Cos or Romaine-type lettuce. It has large, succulent, mint-green outer leaves surrounding crystal-white hearts: mild, sweet, and crunchy in flavor. Succulent heads come up to 10" in height and definitely stand out in the salad garden.
Vegetable	Lettuce (Romaine)	Truchas Mini	21-48	This deep-red, mini-romaine is a game-changer for Caesar salads! 'Truchas' is compact and easy to grow in small spaces and beautifully complements green lettuces. Uniform leaves stay upright in the garden and are easy to clean.
Vegetable	Mustard	Japanese Giant Red	40	Beautiful, large, Japanese type. Purple-red leaves with a delicious, strong, sharp, almost garlic-like, mustard flavor. Tasty stir-fried or boiled and makes a great pickling variety.
Vegetable	Mustard	Southern Giant Curled	40-65	Large, upright plants with crumpled leaves that have a delicious mustard taste; slow to bolt and very easy to grow. An old heirloom from the Southern U.S. and makes a mighty swell mess of greens.
Vegetable	Mustard	Tsa Tsai Round	115-120 (stems)	Heirloom. Brassica juncea var. linearfolia. Cool season annual. Tsa Tsai is a popular and unique mustard variety from Southwest China and called Szechuan or Sichuan vegetable. It is also known as swollen stem mustard or pressed stem mustard because the stem enlarges into thick tuber-like bumps just below the petioles.
Vegetable	Mustard	Cut & Come Again	40	A blend of the best tasting, quick- growing smooth and frilled leafy mustards. A perfect quick crop for continuous cool season zesty salads or nutritious and flavorful stir-fries.

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Vegetable	Mustard	Gai Choy	40	Gai Choy's pungent, classic Chinese mustard flavor is enjoyed predominately in Chinese, Korean, and Japanese cuisines. Also known as Indian mustard, mustard cabbage, and Swatow mustard, Gai Choy has curled leaves that form a head and has wide, crunchy stems. The flavor is mild when young and makes an excellent baby green (heads form as plants mature). Cooking also softens the flavor. Enjoy as a salad green in just 40 days and braise, stir-fry, or pickle when mature.
Vegetable	Mustard	Mizuna	30-50	A graceful plant in flower beds and containers, and also a tender, mildly spicy, Japanese mustard green that is milder than other mustards, and ready to harvest in as little as 3 weeks as tender baby greens.
Vegetable	Onion - Bunching	Delicious Duo	65	Enjoy colorful salads and sautées with our unique blend of tender- crisp green and red scallions with straight stalks and juicy flesh. Bred for high quality, heat tolerance and disease resistance, they are perfect to spring plant and harvest well into summer.
Vegetable	Onion - Bunching	Guardsman	50	Guardsman will be producing salad-ready scallions in July, less than 2 months from a spring sowing! The strong 22 inch plants are supported by a vigorous root system and feature tasty, clean white bulbs topped by emerald green foliage.
Vegetable	Onion - Bunching	Heirloom Italian Scallion	60-65	Burgundy-colored outer wrapper leaves, and white interior flesh that is juicy, succulent and richly flavorful without being overly strong. They taste absolutely delicious sliced into salads or stir fries, egg dishes, or topping pizza.

Vegetable	Onion - Bunching	Italian Red of Florence	60	The oblong shape makes for easier cutting and more uniform slices! The red bulbs also contain anthocyanin, a healthful antioxidant.
Vegetable	Onion - Bunching	Nebuka Evergreen	60-90	The stalks of 'Nebuka Evergreen Bunching' onions grow twelve to sixteen inches tall, multiply by division, and do not form bulbs under most conditions. They are a great multipurpose Japanese bunching variety suitable for fresh eating, stir fry, or any recipe calling for green onions.
Vegetable	Onion - Bunching	Red Beard	65	The Red Beard Bunching variety is a specialty bunching onion with red stalks and a mild flavor. The bunching onion is one of the most important types of onions in Asia and has been grown in China for thousands of years.

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Vegetable	Onion - Bunching	Tokyo Long White	65	These Japanese scallions are long, slender, and mild. Slice these sweet onions and juicy, bluish-green tops into salads, soups, stews, and stir-fry dishes.
Vegetable	Onion - Bunching	White Lisbon	60	White Lisbon' is a green or spring onion, and sometimes referred to as a scallion or bunching onion.
Vegetable	Pak Choi	Green Fortune (F1)	45	Heat-resistant baby variety rapidly produces cute and chubby mini heads of pak choi whose crispy pastel stalks and deep green leaves size up and are ready to eat in record time. Perfect for spring or fall planting, and very ornamental in neat garden beds or rows, the 6-8" compact, vase-shaped heads are mild, sweet and crunchy. This easy to grow vegetable makes wonderful quick stir fries, or braise it for a succulent side dish.
Vegetable	Pak Choi	Green Jewel Mini (F1)	45	Green Jewel Minis are cute, fast growing, healthy and truly delectable! These baby Pak Choi grow just 4" tall and about 5" in diameter. They are heavy for their size, with squared off bottoms and thick, juicy, pearly-white stalks and bright green leaves.
Vegetable	Pak Choi	White Stem	45-75	Produces large, green leaves off a thick, white stem. Leaves have a mild and peppery flavor, making them an exciting addition to many dishes. This hardy garden crop can be grown in climate zones one through nine. After around seventy days, the leaves can be harvested. They can be kept for three months after harvesting.
Vegetable	Radicchio	Nettuno Sugarloaf	80	This sugarloaf produces dense, teardrop shaped heads of sweet, succulent greens balanced with a light touch of bitter.

Vegetable	Pea	Alaska (Shelling)	58-68	This pea variety features vines that are 2.5' tall and pods about 2.5" long. Alaska Pea's small, smooth peas are excellent for canning! This sturdy and nutritious pea variety is an easy and reliable choice for your home garden, providing vitamins A, B, and C and outstanding resistance to wilt.
Vegetable	Pea	Blue Bantam (Shelling)	77-80	Introduced by Burpee in 1902, this heirloom pea variety won over gardeners with its delicious flavor, earliness, quality, and bountiful production.
